Head Coach Sara Myers 8th Season 78-57 Overall Record

Sara Myers is in her second stint as the head coach and her eighth season overall. In her six previous seasons she went 78-57. In 2008, she guided the Lady Colonels to a program record 18-4 season and a trip to the ECAC playoffs. The

Lady Colonels finished 15-4 in 2009 making their second straight trip to the postseason. During both the 2008 and 2009 seasons Wilkes became regionally and nationally ranked for the first time in school history. During her six seasons as head coach, Myers has coached one NFHCA All-Region selection, 25 MAC Freedom All-Conference players and four Rookie of the Year selections. Myers was named Freedom Conference Coach of the Year after the 2008 season.



Assistant Coach Lunda Dickson 6th Season

Lunda Dickson returns for her sixth season on the Lady Colonels sideline. Dickson had a fine career at Misericordia University where she was named PAC Rookie of the Year, PAC Honorable Mention during her sophomore and junior

years and PAC Second Team as a senior. Dickson currently serves as Director of Coaching and Administration for KaPow Hockey Klub.
