In just one year, Brown coached six Colonels who earned All-MAC honors. Under Brown's guidance, the Colonels offense ranked in the top five in several offensive statistical categories

including passing yards and plays per-game. In a game at Delaware Valley in 2014, the Wilkes offense ran 113 plays, a Division III regulation game record.

Brown came to Wilkes after serving as the quarterbacks and special teams' coordinator at Muhlenberg. Prior to that, Brown spent four seasons as offensive coordinator and quarterbacks coach at Lehigh University following one year with the tight ends and four with the wide receivers at the University of Pennsylvania, where he coached the two most prolific receivers in program history. Prior to his arrival at Penn, Brown spent three seasons as an assistant coach at Stanford University.

A native of Longmont, Colorado, Brown earned his bachelor's University of Colorado and his master's degree Saint Mary's College of California.

#### **OFFENSE**

We are a No-Huddle/Up Tempo Offense that looks to gain an advantage by playing fast. Schematically we feature a multiple launch point passing game and a zone running scheme. Our aim is to be balanced between the run and the pass. Our goal is to emphasize the strengths of our football team, and get the ball in the playmakers hands. We want to be both explosive and physical as an Offense.

#### **DEFENSE**

Wilkes Defense is an aggressive, Multiple-Odd Front. We utilize 3-3 Stack and 3-4 spacing in conjunction with a variety of Stunts, Blitzes, Coverages, and Disguises to attack opposing Offenses. Strength, Speed, and Toughness provide the foundation for our scheme.

#### **SPECIAL TEAMS**

The goal of the Wilkes Special Teams Unit is to create an advantage that helps the football team win. An emphasis is placed on Speed, to help gain and maintain field position, create scoring opportunities and make big plays. A player who is not ready to be a full-time Offensive or Defensive player can earn the opportunity to impact games by contributing on Special Teams.


