Head Coach Chris Leicht 15th Season 408-92 Overall Record

Leicht begins his fifteenth season at the helm of the women's tennis team, and is coming off one of the most successful years in the programs history. Leicht led the Colonels to a 21-3 record and their 10th straight MAC Freedom Championship and 10th consecutive NCAA Tournament appear-

10th consecutive NCAA Tournament appearance. Leicht is a nine-time Freedom Conference Coach of the Year recipient. While at Wilkes, he has coached 46 All-MAC Freedom performers since 2003 including eight conference players of the year and five conference rookies of the year. Leicht has also led his team to many academic awards. His tennis teams have been named ITA All-American Academic teams thirteen times and several individuals have been All-American academic achievers. He is a 2000 graduate of Bloomsburg University, earning a degree in Business Administration. He also earned his Masters in Business Administration at Bloomsburg University. Leicht also serves as the Director of the Recreation and Athletic Center (RAC) at the University.



#### Graduate Assistant Younes Hidass First Season

Younes Hidass begins his first season at Wilkes following a fine playing career at Queens College where he played both No. 1 single and doubles. Hidass was named First Team All-ECC both years he attended. Hidass also has an extensive career as a coach, working at the John McEnroe

Tennis Academy, in addition to playing and learning from multiple professionals and a former NCAA Division I Champion.

#### **Ralston Athletic Complex**

The Ralston Athletic Complex is currently undergoing a three-phase, \$3 million renovation that helped resurface the tennis courts. Also included in the complex is Munson Field House; Schmidt Stadium for football,



soccer, field hockey and lacrosse; a stadium for softball; a grass soccer field and two football practice fields.
